

Bylaws¹ on the procedure for appointment of the Liaison Person for the Residents of the European College of Veterinary Public Health (ECVPH)

Introduction.

The Liaison Person is an Ordinary Member of the Council. The main task of the Liaison Person is to represent the Residents in the Council.

The Liaison Person is a Diplomate of the ECVPH who has completed the residency programme and passed the College examination within the last five years in accordance with the policy established by the Council.

Article 1: Nomination of the Liaison Person.

The Liaison Person is nominated to the Nomination Committee at least thirty days in advance of any regular or special meeting of the College, at which the election can be finalised. Only one Liaison Person is nominated.

Article 2: Election of the Liaison Person.

Exempt from the nomination process of Ordinary Members, the nominated Liaison Person shall be elected in the same manner as the other officers by a majority of members voting for a period of two years. The Liaison Person shall be eligible for re-election. The Liaison Person will serve for the elected period or until her / his successor shall have been elected.
