Travel

Berlin can easily be reached by

- plane using the Berlin-Brandenburg Airport (<https://ber.berlin-airport.de/en.html>)
- train from various directions (<https://www.bahn.com/en>)
- car using either highways A2, A9, A11 or A24
- taxi from the BER (approx. 50 EUR one way)
- by boat through various waterways and rivers 😊

The geocoordinates of the venue are 52°25'46.1"N and 13°14'11.8"E

In your navigation system, enter **Oertzenweg 19b, 14163 Berlin** to be guided to the venue
Free (albeit sometimes limited) car parking is available on Campus and in the neighborhood

Closest public transport stops are

S1 “Mexikoplatz”

North of the campus; 12 minutes walking via Urselweg & Wolzogenstrasse

Bus 112 and N18 “Wolzogenstrasse” via Wolzogenstrasse

North of Campus, 5 minutes walking via Wolzogenstrasse

Bus 118 and 622 “Clauertstrasse”

West of Campus, 7 minutes walking via Clauertstrasse and Königsweg

Tickets for the public transport system (Berlin ABC pass) will be provided electronically for the four days (We – Sa) through the conference organizer. Accommodation options

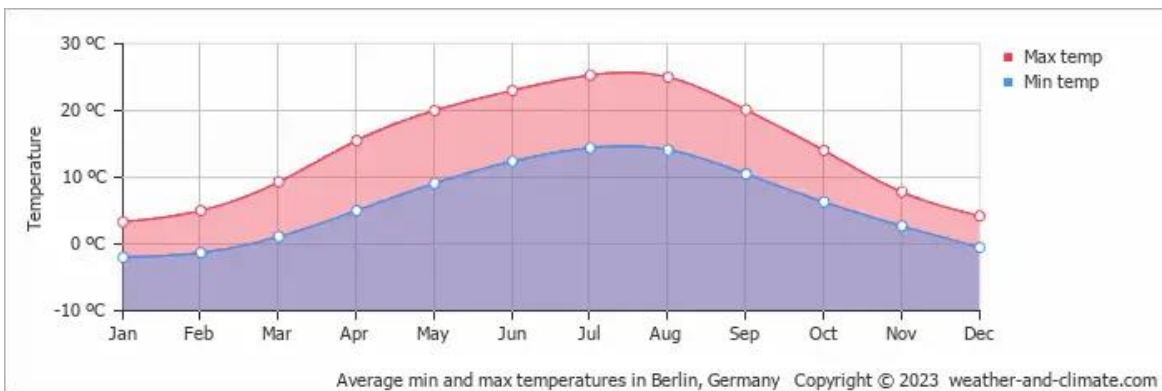
There are various hotels of different price ranges within “normal” (at least for Berlin) distance to the campus, i.e. taking 20-40 minutes by public transport and walking to get there. Given that the availability and prices frequently change we recommend to consult your standard hotel booking platforms and look in the areas of Zehlendorf-Steglitz (S1, Bus 112), Wannsee & Potsdam (Bus 118, S7, S1, regional train RE1) or Klein Machnow-Stahnsdorf (Bus 622). A list of possible hotels can be found at the end of this document. Close to the S-Station Wannsee there is a large well equipped Youth Hostel that might provide small group accommodation.



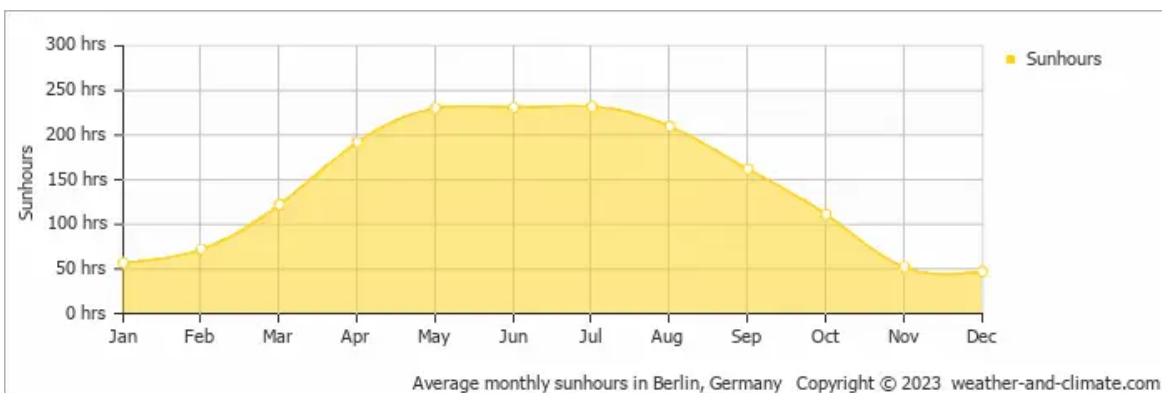
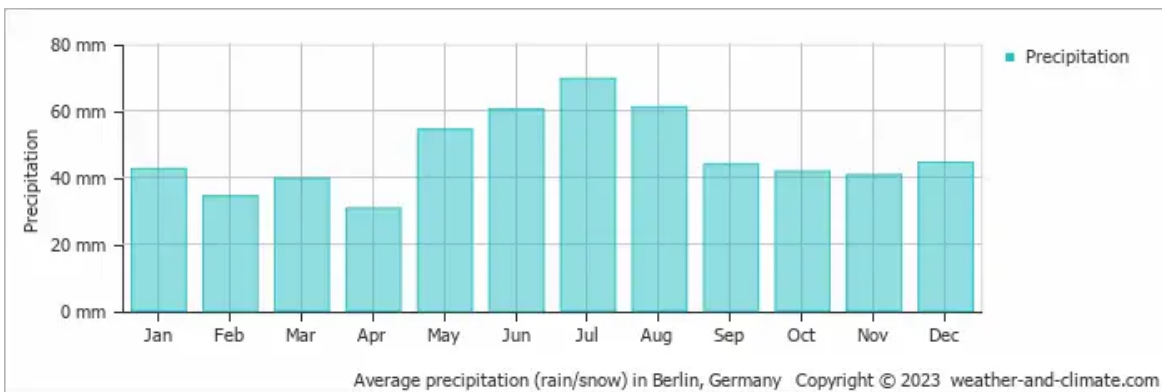
The weather in mid-September can still be very nice and sunny, but could also start to become cooler and rainy so be prepared for both.

List of hotels in reasonable distance

The order is arbitrary and does not reflect any judgement or preference.

Costs / day are estimates and will depend on the timing of your booking and choices made!

Hotel Bonverde, Train/S-Station Wannsee (<http://bonverde.de/>)

Simple hotel, good connection to regional transport, Single room starting at approx. 60 € w/o breakfast; to get to the Campus take Bus 118 towards Berlin Krumme Lanke until stop Clauertstrasse, 5 min walking from there via Königsweg

Youth Hostel Wannsee (<https://www.jugendherberge.de/en/youth-hostels/berlin-am-wannsee/portrait/>)

Nicely located well-equipped youth hostel with (small) group accommodation, breakfast is included. To get to the Campus take Bus 218 to S-Wannsee, change to Bus 118 towards Berlin Krumme Lanke until stop Clauertstrasse, 5 min walking from there via Königsweg; alternatively walk 500 m to S Nikolaisee, take S1 towards Berlin to Mexikoplatz and walk 10 min to the Campus

Hotel Landhaus Schlachtensee, S-Station Mexikoplatz (<http://hotel-landhaus-schlachtensee.de/startseite.html>)

Nice smaller hotel; single room approx. 80 € w/o breakfast; close to Mexikoplatz; to get to the Campus either take bus 118 until stop Clauertstrasse or walk directly (approx. 20 minutes)

Hotel Steglitz International, S-Station Rathaus Steglitz (<http://www.si-hotel.com/>)

Standard chain hotel, good connection to regional transport, single room approx. 100€ w/o breakfast, to get to the Campus take S1 towards Wannsee until stop Mexikoplatz, then take bus 118 until stop Clauertstrasse; 5 min walking from there via Königsweg. Alt. walk 10 min. from S Mexikoplatz to the Campus

Hotel NH Berlin Potsdam Conference Center (<https://www.nh-hotels.de/hotel/nh-berlin-potsdam-conference-center>)

Quiet nice location, good hotel with sauna and restaurant, single room approx. 200€ w/o breakfast, to get to Campus take Bus 622 until stop Clauertstrasse, 5 min walking from there via Königsweg

Seminaris Campus Hotel, FU main campus close to U-Station Dahlem-Dorf ([Seminaris CampusHotel Berlin | Seminaris](http://SeminarisCampusHotelBerlin.com))

On the FU campus, single room approx. 90€ with breakfast, to get to campus take U3 towards Krumme Lanke (terminal station), then continue with Bus 118 to stop Clauertstrasse, 5 min walking from there via Königsweg

Hotel zum Hofmaler, charming hotel within walking distance from Potsdam main train station, approx. 75-90€/ night. <https://www.hofmaler-hotel-potsdam.de/preisliste.html>

B&B Hotel Potsdam, standard chain hotel; right across Potsdam main train station, approx. 110€/night

For all Potsdam Hotels:

From Potsdam main station, take S7 or a regional train towards Berlin, switch in Wannsee to either Bus 118 towards Krumme Lanke until stop Clauertstrasse or S1 until stop Mexikoplatz, and walk from there.
